


### Columbarium Pricing Structure

#### Niche

1. Lump sum payment - \$2,000  
(Plus additional fees for engraving)
2. Partial payments - \$2,300  
*(\$500 down payment and 3 annual installments of \$600 due March 1st of each successive year. Plus additional fees for engraving)*

# First Presbyterian Church Columbarium

## The Columbarium

The Columbarium is a place at First Presbyterian Church for the reverent placement of cremated remains and for the memorializing of others interred elsewhere. Cremated remains are placed in a niche in the Columbarium wall or in the Memorial Garden.

The Columbarium provides a peaceful outdoor setting for meditation, prayer and a place for the remains of those who have a sense of closeness to First Presbyterian Church.



The Columbarium is designed to meet the growing trend of our society to use cremation at the time of death while providing an opportunity to entomb and honor family members on the grounds of the church.

## Location and Description

The Columbarium is located adjacent to the exterior walls of the Sanctuary and the Parlor. Multiple stone walls hold niches for the entombment of cremated remains and a landscaped area is designated for the placing of ashes. Each niche has a faceplate which is engraved after ashes are placed in the niche. The cremated remains of two people can be placed in one niche



Areas designated for memorial plaques are located in the interior of the Columbarium to memorialize those individuals whose ashes have been placed within the Memorial Garden and those whose final resting place is in another location. The design complements the architectural features of the Sanctuary and the landscaping on the church campus.

## Who May Choose To Use The Columbarium?

Church members, their immediate families, church staff past and present, ordained ministers of First Presbyterian Church including their immediate families may use the Columbarium. The same persons are eligible to be on the memorial plaques if their final resting place is in another location. Additional information regarding eligibility to use the Columbarium is available in the church office and website



## How Are Columbarium Niches Reserved?

Agreement forms to reserve the use of the Columbarium facilities are available in the church office or on the website. A Columbarium agreement is issued when completed forms and appropriate fees are returned to the church office. Additional information regarding fees is also available in the church office.
